### **INFORMATION**

#### **Annual General Meeting**

The Society is required under its rules to hold an annual general meeting to report to and answer queries from the general membership of the Society and adopt the annual accounts for 2019. In these unprecedented times with all the attendant risks associated with Covid 19, the Management Committee are conscious of the requirements to comply with public health advice and ensure full social distancing rules are applied at the AGM. Attendance within the venue will therefore be limited to 60 people. Of course the membership are entitled to attend and raise any queries, however, in the circumstances prevailing at present members are asked to consider submitting their queries or comments in writing to the Secretary by 10th July and they will be addressed at the AGM and a written response provided thereafter.

#### **Review of Covid 19 Refund of Subscriptions**

The Management Committee reviewed the partial refund of subscriptions provided to members in May and June by way of a payment into your bank account. They were concerned to note that overall payments for inpatient hospital care for the first six months of the year was reduced by less than 2% in circumstances where the Private Hospitals were re-designated as Public Hospitals for the months of April and May and were not treating private patients. Of greater concern is the backlog of deferred surgical procedures and various medical treatments that will require to be addressed over the coming months. The Private Hospitals have indicated their intention to supply services at weekends and late evenings to alleviate this backlog over time. Furthermore, they are seeking to impose additional charges to cover Covid 19 tests prior to surgery and the use of additional personal protective equipment. In those circumstances, the Management Committee consider it to be imprudent to approve any further refund of subscriptions. They wish to assure members that any savings accruing will go towards delaying future premium increases for longer, having last applied an increase over three years ago on 1st June 2017.

#### **Submission of Claims**

The Society's staff will continue to work from home for the foreseeable future in compliance with public health advice. You can submit your claims electronically by scanning the documents or by post which is collected regularly from the An Post mail centre and distributed to staff for assessment. When staff return to the office, it will not be possible to visit the office except by prior appointment and only in respect of urgent issues that cannot be dealt with by phone or email. This provision will remain in place until 2021 to protect staff and indeed members and reduce the risk of infection by the virus.
